Titles awarded

CAJC, CAC, res. CAC, Club Show Winner of youth, Club Show Winner, BOV, BOB, BOS, BIS

Best puppy, best puppy dog / bitch; Best minor puppy; Best junior, best junior dog / bitch; Best in colours

Classes

- minor puppy class since the complete vaccination – 6 months
- puppy class 6 – 9 months
- junior class 9 – 18 months
- intermediate class 15 – 24 months
- open class open from 15 months
- champion class open from 15 months with champion title
- veteran class above 8 years
- honour class without report from the judge, for dogs with champion title

Competitions

To compete in these classes/competitions, the dogs must be registered individually in one of the compulsory classes

- Best brace a dog and a bitch of the same breed and variety and belonging to the same owner
- Best breeder's group consisting of minimum three and maximum five exhibits of the same breed and variety, without distinction of sex, bred by the same person (same kennel name), even if they are not his/her property
- Best progeny group a sire or dam with minimum three and maximum five of his progeny (first generation, sons/daughters)
- Handling Handlers will compete in three categories – 1. Child and the cavalier (children of age from 3 to 9 years); 2. Junior handling (handlers from 10 up to 18 years); 3 – Cavalier Handling (adult handlers).

Exhibitor commits himself/herself to pay the entry fees also in case he will not participate at the show whatever the reason.

Dogs entered into Puppy and Veteran classes cannot be considered as "first dog". Discount for any additional dog can only be offered if the name and address of the additional dog's owner is fully identical with the name and address of the first dog's owner.

If no copy of champion certificate is submitted, the dog will be transferred to the open class. Certificates received after the entry close will not be accepted.

General provisions

1. Age in the day of the show determines the class in which dog will be presented.
2. Only dogs registered with stud books acknowledged by FCI can take part at the show. Dogs must be registered in a national stud book in the country of owner's residence
3. Registration to any class of the show must be accompanied by the copy of the pedigree
4. Should the organisers of a show be forced to cancel the event for reasons of force majeure, the collected entry fees will be used to cover the costs that have already been incurred.
5. The organising committee reserves the right to reject the participation of any exhibitor to the show.
6. Organiser cannot be held responsible for any casualty caused by a dog or to a dog. The owner and exhibitor is responsible for any damage caused by a dog.
7. Only dogs stated in a catalogue can be shown. It is not possible to enrol the dog on the day of the show. Changing classes on the day of the show is not possible. A judge must exclude from judging any dog who is behaving aggressively. It is not allowed to heckle dogs against each other. It is forbidden to treat the coat, skin or nose with anything that alters the structure, colour or form (spray, powder and other cosmetic products).
8. Bitches in season, milking or pregnant are not allowed to be presented in the ring.
9. Double handling from outside the ring is not allowed.
10. It is strictly forbidden to leave the dog tied up on the trimming table longer than necessary for the preparation.
11. Breaking of any of these rules can lead to excluding the dog from the show.
12. Owners of the dogs must present the pet passports with records on valid vaccinations on arrival. Effective vaccination on rabies, parvovirus and distemper is compulsory.
13. The name of the dog and all the details as recorded in the pedigree must be given on this entry form. If an error is made the dog may be disqualified by the Show Committee.
14. Puppies under 3 months of age on the first day of the Show cannot be entered for competition. On no account will entries be accepted without fees.
15. Dogs entered in a breach of the kennel club show regulations are liable for disqualification whether or not the owner was aware of the breach.
16. By submitting the entry of his/her dog, the exhibitor is obliged to abide by the SKJ/FCI show regulations and Slovak veterinary rules. The exhibitor is giving his/her permission to publish his/her address in the exhibition catalogue and on the website of the organizer. He/she also agrees with publishing pictures, results and critiques of his/her dog as much as needed by the organizer, the SKJ or partners of the show. The entry of a dog is financially binding.

Declaration

1. We agree to submit to and be bound by the kennel club rules and regulations in their present form or as they may be amended from time to time in relation to all canine matters with which the kennel club is concerned and that this entry is made upon the basis that all current single or joint registered owners of this dog have authorised/consented to this entry.
2. We also undertake to abide by the regulations of this show and not to bring to the show any dog which has contracted or been knowingly exposed to any infectious or contagious disease during the 21 days prior to the show, or which is suffering from a visible condition which adversely affects its health or welfare or to bring any dog which has been prepared for exhibition contrary to the kennel club regulations for the preparation of dogs for exhibition.
3. We declare that I believe to the best of my knowledge that the dogs are not liable to disqualification under the kennel club show regulations.
